

# Guidelines for Better Legal Information in Ontario

## Quick review checklist

Check to make sure your legal information website or resource:

- Tells users who produced the information
- States the intended audience or purpose
- States the jurisdiction where the information applies
- Has been reviewed by a legal expert
- States the date of last review by a legal expert
- Is written in plain language
- Uses clean design
- Includes referrals to free or low-cost legal assistance
